SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.

- Beakulen is under the jurisdiction of a Tentera Masional Indonesia (TNI) brigade commanded by Lt. Col. Berlian. Berlian is twenty-three years old and a native of Hana, in the Benkulen Residency. The town is occurried by a battalion from this brigade, which is commanded by Newawi, a twenty-two year old major in the TNI.
- 2. The Regent of Benkulen, Marusman, is a graduate of the Dutch Middlebare Opleidings School Voor Inlandsche Ambtenaren ("Native Civil Officers" School ) and is said to be anti-Republic; however, he was forced to remain in office. Marusman did a great deal for the safety of the Chinese community at Benkulen.
- 3. The airfield at Benkulen is about eight kilometers south of the city at Pekan Saptu. It was built by the Japanese in 1943-1944.
- The Pasindo has a branch at Benkulen and an estimated 1,000 members. They are taught the principles of Communism by Raden Hanifah, the local president, who was formerly a teacher in the local Taman Siewa school. His assistant is Raden Abdullah, who was formerly sub-prosecutor in the pre-war Dutch court of justice there. The organization is regarted to be well-armed.
- The Anakatan Latit Republik Indonesia has a detechment of about 60 men at Benkulen armed with rifles and two light machine guns. Their present assignment is to guard the coset.
- The gold mine at Rebong-Tandai, near Lubuklinggau, is producing gold at the rate of about eight kilograms a year. The Redjang-Lebong mines have been closed.
