 Colonel Juan FERNANDEZ Capalleja, reportedly another YAGUE follower, is a close friend of Carlos RUIZ Garcia, Civil Governor of Madrid and new head of the Falange Information Service, who also, sympathetic toward YAGUE's plan. RUIZ Garcia reportedly submitted his resignation to FRANCO who refused to accept it because he considers RUIZ Garcia a loyal adherent of the present regime. Furthermore, it is rumored that RUIZ Garcia will replace the Minister of the Interior Blan PEREZ, a change which would substantially aid YAGUE's movement.


