Under the pretext of combating illiteracy in Southeast Asia, Kalinov will have Communist propaganda booklets distributed in backward areas in Southeast Asia in languages ranging from Arabic Malay to Mandarin Chinese. In his educational program, he teaches anti-capitalism, anti-imperialism, "hunger for territorial aggrandizement," how to sabotage, how to bring about general strakes, how to wage guerrilla warfare, and how to train cadres for all these purposes.
