COLLECTOR'S PRELIMINARY GRADING OF CONTENT

In a confidential letter to President RHFE Syngman, dated & January 1949, Dr. Henry De Young, Special Representative to SCAP from the Republic of Korea, proposed that Mr. CHICE Ho (佳 告) of the Kong Saeng Company (共生線本社), Seoul be given official permission for the purchase and resale in the United States of some scrap iron, the proceeds of which would go to the support of a Korean "Publicity Foundation" in America.
