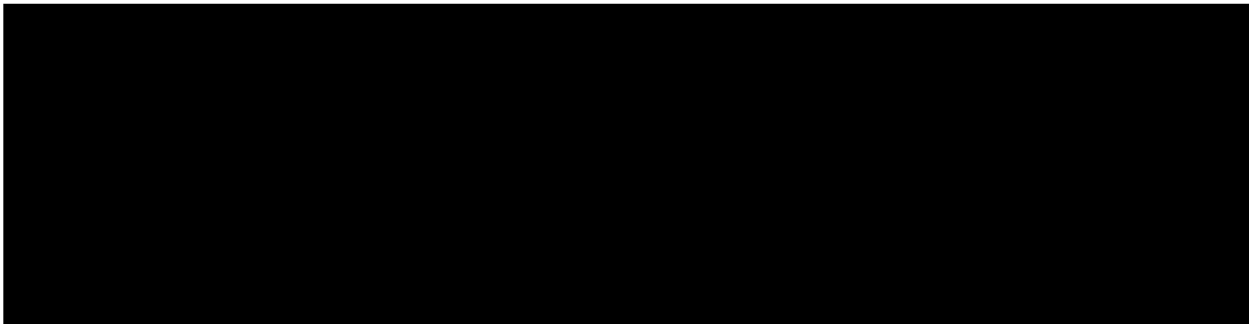

1. Pesik (fnu), the political representative of the Indonesian Republic in Manila, has asked Indonesian Republicans in exile in New Delhi for clarification of his position and for the necessary official credentials. Pesik originally arrived in Manila to pave the way for Doctor Ratu Langi who was to represent the Indonesian Republic in the Philippines. Ratu Langi failed to arrive in the Philippines, however, because of Dutch police action. Comment. According to Indonesian Republic officials in Manila are in contact with the interior of Indonesia through an Indonesian group in New Delhi. Communications between Manila and New Delhi are by cable.)
2. Pesik claims that Indonesian officials Harsono, Saroso, Sumitro and Sjafruddin (Prawiranegara) are personally committed to the American Indonesian Corporation because of monetary favors. Pesik is using personal funds to avoid obligation to the American Indonesian Corporation.
3. In Manila, drives for the Red Cross and for the Boy Scouts have temporarily postponed the Aid to Indonesia campaign.
4. Pesik has just been informed by the New Delhi office that all supplies for the Indonesian Republic are being delivered to Penang, Malaya, from which place they are shipped to Sumatra by PT boat (). Supplies needed are arms, ammunition, medicine and clothing. Payment for these supplies is made in cash or in crepe rubber sheets.
