The Communist Party of Mexico (PCM) has shown considerable interest in the trip recently made to Latin America by the United States Representatives, Robert B. Chipperfield, Bartel J. Jonkman, Lawrence H. Smith, Peter Jarman, Thomas S. Gordon, and Mike Mansfield. In a letter written by Manuel Terrazas, a member of the Political Bureau of the Central Committee of the PCM, to Pedro J. Abella, Secretary General of the Communist-dominated Confederacion de Trabajadores de Colombia (CTC), Terrazas stated that he believed the main purpose of the congressmen's trip had been to observe Communist activities in Latin America. He requested that Abella inform him of the views of the Colombian Communists on the matter and give him an account of the activities of the congressmen while they were in Bogota.
