Only about three school inspectors in Bangkok know Chinese, and even these people are not sufficiently familiar with the various dialects to be able to determine just what is being taught in the schools. Some mais teachers appear at school wearing only short pants, no shirts, and are visited by numerous unscholarly-looking adults after class hours in the schools.
