1. The approximately 500 Chinese private schools in Siam must be checked on constantly to prevent their being used for teaching Communist or Kuomintang propaganda during the day, and for meeting places of Chinese political societies at night. Some "teachers" at these schools have been unable to show certifications of educational qualifications, and have been forbidden to teach.
2. Only about three school inspectors in Bangkok know Chinese, and even these people are not sufficiently familiar with the various dialects to be able to determine just what is being taught in the schools. Some male teachers appear at school wearing only short pants, no shirts, and are visited by numerous unscholarly-looking adults after class hours in the schools.
