

SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.

- On 1 January 1949 all non-commissioned officers of the Hungarian Army, boxxx between 1916 and 1924, who had been pensioned or dismissed because they had fled to the West in 1944-45, were recalled to active duty. No publicity was given to their reactivation; they were summoned individually to report for duty.
- 2. The new Hungarian training and indoctrination schools are being run according to regulations in force in the Soviet Army.
- 3. Since the fall of 1948, 11 colonels, Seven lieutenant colonels, 19 majors, 13 captakus and 127 "training officers" (officer candidates?) of the Hungarian Army have been sent to the USSR to attend various military courses.
