

SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.

The Communist Party of Chile issued the following instructions to the cells in Santiago prior to 7 February 1949:

- 1. All militants must be in the vicinity of the Estadio Chile on 7 February to march down Avenida Ejercito and continue in parade to Plaza Ercilla. This order must be complied with even though the government should announce a suspension of assembly. Those in charge shall forward this to the cells and those militants who do not comply will be turned over to the Disciplinary Tribumal.
- 2. The money-collecting campaign will terminate before 15 February. The object is to collect 500,000 peacs for propaganda expenses. To date 200,000 peacs have been collected, but 300,000 more are needed to install a new printing press with the machinery formerly used by the El Siclo.
- 3. It is necessary also to have the funds for aiding the "persecuted" before 15 February. These funds can be collected from house to house, and by means of lotteries. Each militant is obliged to sell at least 10 numbers on every lottery at 10 pesos per number.
- 4. Attend and get sympathizers to attend the Fiesta which will be held 8 February, in the Teatro Colisco, and sell admission tickets for the dances which will be in conformance with a program of the Local Committee of Cantiago.
