- In November 1947, large underground bases for guided missiles and pilotless aircraft were completed at:

Liubirgis* (Kaunas district)
 Linksmakalnis " "
 Porubanek and Juodoji (Vilnius district)
 Maseikiai (56°18'N, 22°E) along the Minijs River

In January 1948, there was a heavy traffic to these sites in machinery, steel tanks, and bottles. Small radio stations have been set up at each place, with aerials 10 to 12 meters long. There are strong anti-aircraft defenses.

- Other guided missile bases are reported to be already in existence at Kretinga (55°45'N, 21°E), Liepaja (Latvia), and Paldiski (Estonia). Bases are under construction at Kaliningrad (formerly Königsberg), Daugavpils (Latvia), and Lida (Poland).
- Factories for the production of guided missiles are under construction at Kirovakan (40°48'N, 44°30'E) and at Stepanakert (39°50'N, 46°46'E). All the German prisoners-of-war in the camp at Kirovakan are being used on this work, as well as a number of women prisoners. One of the latter is the daughter of Koch, former Gauleiter of East Prussia.
- Radar stations are reported to be in operation at Kronstadt and Tallinn. In the latter port, there is a radar training center. (May 1948)
- Packages believed to contain guided missile components arrived during July 1948 by sea at Klaipeda and Liepaja, and by rail at Maseikiai and Daugavpils. These packages, which were covered with packing cloth, were of iron and steel and had the following dimensions:
 - 4.5 meters long, diameter 1.5 meters
 - 11.5 meters long, diameter 2.2 meters

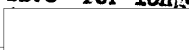
