

> Ing. Giacomo Recupito, Managing Director of CEMSA (Caproni Elettro Meccanica di Saronno) left Rome on 19 January 1949 for Cairo to negotiate the sale to the Egyptian government of the following war supplies (quantities unspecified):

- a. 50-ton Caproni pocket-submarines.
- b. Baglietto motor gunboats.
- c. M4 tanks purchased by Caproni from Italian surplus stock.
- d. 76 mm and 90 mm cannon, described as "available from Italian Government sources".
- s. 81 mm and 120 mm CEMBA mortars.
- f. CA-313 aircraft.
