- 1. All buildings at Peeneminde have been dismantled. On 5 December 1948, German workmen were busy removing all remaining material at the research station, including telephone installations, heating pipes, electric wiring. There has been no firing of weapons at Peeneminde since late 1946.
- 2. At Ueckerminde (Q18), the former Chemische Sprengstoff- und Dynamit-Fabriken, earlier dismantled, was being gone over in December 1948 by German workmen under the supervision of a local Soviet Army unit. The purpose was to salvage whatever material remained on the premises.
