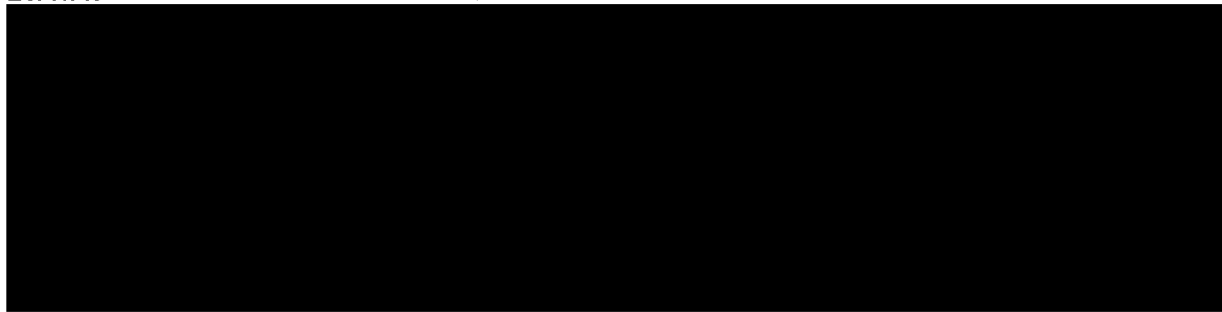

1. The Tentera Nasional Indonesia, concentrated at Sungaipenuh and other rice growing sections of Kurintji, are expecting arms and ammunition from Pakistan and Hindustan. According to reports, arms are being sent to Tapan, on the Indian Ocean coast of Sumatra.

[REDACTED] believes that General K. M. Carippa, commander-in-chief of the Indian Army, and General Sir Douglas Gracey, commander-in-chief of the Pakistan Army, intend to send light armaments and ammunition to supplement Tentera Nasional Indonesia equipment in Sumatra. The Achinese Brigade with headquarters in Kutaradjah will receive the greatest share.
