- Wilhelm J.D. Pesik, the representative of the Indonesian Republic in Manila, cabled the Republic of Indonesia office in New Delhi for a list of the supplies desired by the government in Java. The reply indicated the following materials are needed in addition to arms and ammunition:
  - (a) Medical supplies (sulpha drugs, aspirin, thermometers, syringes, and surgical instruments).
  - (b) Textiles (cheap uniform materials).
  - (c) Newsprint.
  - (d) Tires (700x20)

  - (c) Photographic supplies. (f) Radio transmitters and receivers.
  - (g) Flashlight and automobile batteries.
- 2. Pesik was also informed that 1,200 tons of copra can be exported each month from Atjeh. Palm oil, patchouli oil, rubber and coffes are available for export in addition to the copra.
- There are 250,000 armed Republicans in Atjeh.
