On 2 August 1948, Chvedov had a long conversation with Peter Nagy, then Chargé d'Affaires at the Hungarian Legation, apparently in connection with the tightening up of security measures at that Legation,

In June 1948 he was reported to have taken over from Ivan Yanchenko, the Tass correspondent in Cairo, the task of liaison with the Yugoslav Legation. In the weeks before his defection and flight in October 1948, Chahin Chahinpachic, then Yugoslav Charge d'Affaires, was in increasingly frequent touch with Chvedov, who seems to have been the chief instigator of his defection.

Some time in 1246 Chvedov is reported to have been in truch, together with Yanchenko, with a local representative of the Jewish Agency, named Boris Kehanov.

In Hovember 1948 and January 1949 Chvedov visited the Greek Patriarch in Alexandria to arrange the roplacement of Dekhterev (deported by the Egyptian authorities) by Prozorov, as priest of the Russian Orthodex Church in Alexandria.
