- 1. Dutch troops under the command of Colonel Scheffelaar in East Indonesia are as follows:
  - (a) In the Celebes there is stationed one battalion of mixed troops consisting of three field infantry companies, one machine gun platoon, one engineer company and one light field battery. The main force is at Makassar with one infantry company at Manado.
  - (b) On the islands of Bali and Lombok one battalion of field infantry occupies the two islands.
  - (c) Dutch Timor is occupied by one battalion of field infantry which consists of one company at Kupang, one company at Atambua near the border of Portuguese Timor and one company at Ende on the island of Flores.
  - (d) The island of Ambon is occupied by one company and supporting groups in the town of Amboins.
  - (c) One company is divided between Ternate and Halmahera.
  - (f) One company is stationed in New Guinea.
- The islands of Sumbaya, Sumbaya, Roti and others not guarded by the army are protected by police detachments.
- 3. There was a pre-war secret airfield on the island of Alor. There are auxiliary airfields in the convict colony at Atambua, and at Selor and Ternate.
