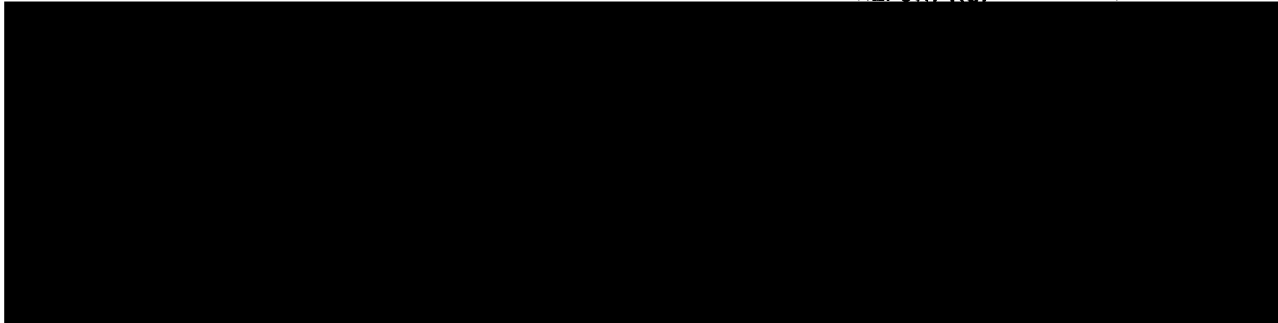

1. The Dutch are becoming suspicious of the Sultan of Pontianak and feel that he and other members of the Bizonder Federaal Overleg (BFO) are turning pro-Republic.
2. Anak Agung Gde Agung is also unpopular with the Dutch, and it is probable that the latter will turn to Abdul Malik as their chief spokesman.
3. The progressive faction in East Indonesia is supporting the objection to East Indonesians enlisting in the Royal Netherlands Indonesian Army (RNIA).
