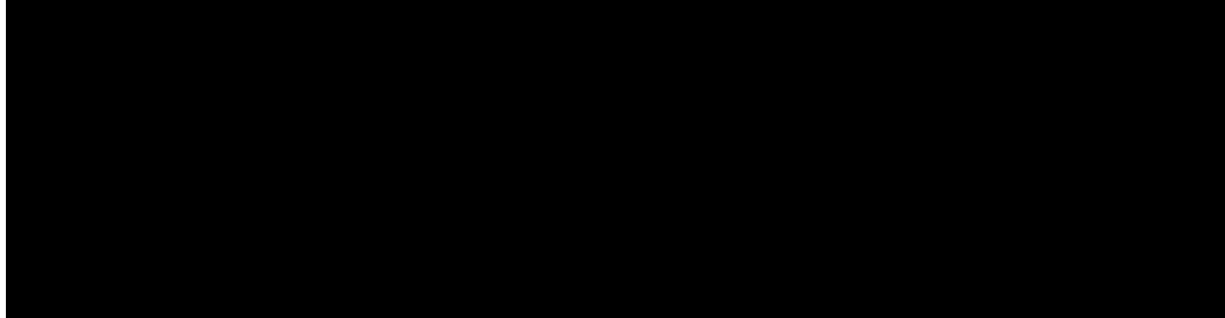

SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.



1. An Argentine five-seater plane landed at Yacuiba, Bolivia, on the Argentine border on 11 April 1949 and the pilot made a call on the Argentine Consul. When he was questioned by Bolivian authorities, the pilot stated that he was bound for Cochabamba, Bolivia. However, he had no papers allowing him or the plane to enter the country. Consequently, Bolivian authorities seized the plane and held it while they made an investigation.
2. Source reports that the Bolivian government is seriously concerned by this incident in view of Argentine aid to Movimiento Nacionalista Revolucionario (MNR) exiles and the desire of the Argentine government to see Hertzog replaced by a regime which would be friendly or subservient to Argentina.
