1. The Belgian Transport Workers' Union, agitating for additional retirement benefits for seamen, on 27 April was to have called a 24-hour strike by Belgian sailors who were in their home ports.
2. On 2 May the Communist-controlled "Action Committee" of the Antwerp dockworkers is to call a 48-hour strike for increased pensions.
3. The Syndicats Unis has announced that its coal miners in the Mons and Charleroi area will go on 48-hour strike for additional high cost of living allowances on 2 May.
