1. Since the prohibition by American Military Government of the meeting of the Nauheim Circle scheduled for 2-3 April in Aschaffenburg, it has been learned that complete information on plans for the meeting had been submitted to Karlshorst several days beforehand. The text of Prof. Ulrich Hoack's speech which was published by ADN (Allgemeine Deutsche Nachrichtenbuero) was not received from a correspondent in the west, but from Soviet sources.
2. The Communist Party in West Germany has been instructed by Berlin to avoid contact with the Nauheim Circle for the present, in order not to handicap the Circle's activities.
3. Heinrich Homann (formerly of the Nationalkomitee Freies Deutschland), a member of the executive committee of the National Democratic Party in Berlin, functions within the committee as a specialist on western Germany. He has personal contact with the Nauheim Circle, and has prepared for the political control officers of the NDP a memorandum on the possibilities of liaison with the leaders of the Nauheim Circle. Late in March Homann began to have daily "informational" conferences with Russian officials in Karlshorst.
