- d. Machinery Construction Bureau for the Paper Industry. Jelenia Gora (Hirschberg).
- 20 All Paper Hills are now grouped into "Przedsiebiorstwa" (groups of factories). · These are on the same level as "Zjednoczenia" (Unions) in other industries.
- The Krapkowickie Zaklady Papiernicze at Krapkowice, Opole District, is one of the Przedsiebiorstwa, and has the following directing personnel:
