- d. Machinery Construction Bureau for the Paper Industry, Jelenia Gora (Hirschberg).
3. All Paper Mills are now grouped into "Przedsiębiorstwa" (groups of factories). These are on the same level as "Zjednoczenia" (Unions) in other industries.
4. The Krapkowickie Zakłady Papiernicze at Krapkowice, Opole District, is one of the Przedsiębiorstwa, and has the following directing personnel:
- Chief Director: Engineer Chmielewski.
 - Technical Director: Engineer Felicjan Klonowski.
 - Trade Director: Slusarczyk.
 - All these men were persuaded to become members of the PZPR (United Workers' Party).

The following mills belong to the Krapkowickie Zakłady Papiernicze:

- Fabryka Celulozy i Papieru w Krapkowicach, Opole District (Cellulose and Paper Mill at Krapkowice). This mill has 4 bleaching vats. The mill is to be developed, since it has larger buildings than others of its kind.
 - Director: Engineer Dziwior, member of the PZPR.
 - Cellulose production: Approximately 1,500 tons monthly.
 - Paper production: About 800 tons monthly.
 - Number of workers: 1,200, including 60 with technical knowledge.
- Fabryka Celulozy i Papieru - Kaloty (Cellulose and Paper Mill at Kaloty, near Tarnowskie Gory, Lubliniec District. This mill has 6 bleaching vats.)
 - Cellulose production: Approximately 2,500 tons monthly.
 - Paper production: Approximately 2,000 tons per month.
 - Number of workers: 1,800, including 140 with technical knowledge.
- Fabryka Papieru w Mlynowie (Paper Mills at Mlynow, Klodzko District). This mill processes the excess of cellulose produced by Kaloty and Krapkowice Mills.
- Fabryka Tekstury - Kolonowska (Cardboard Mill at Kolonowska, 20 kms. W of Lubliniec).

Productions: 400 to 500 tons of cardboard.
- Two Presspan Mills at Natalin and Klepaczka near Poraj. These are the only pressboard mills in Poland. The total monthly production of both mills is approximately 200 tons.
- The following three paper mills, also belonging to the Krapkowice Zakłady Papiernicze, have been completely dismantled (installations and equipment were taken over by the Russians and sent to the USSR):
 - Paper Mill at Jelenia Gora.
 - Paper Mill at Kostrzynek.
 - Paper Mill at Siekierki.
