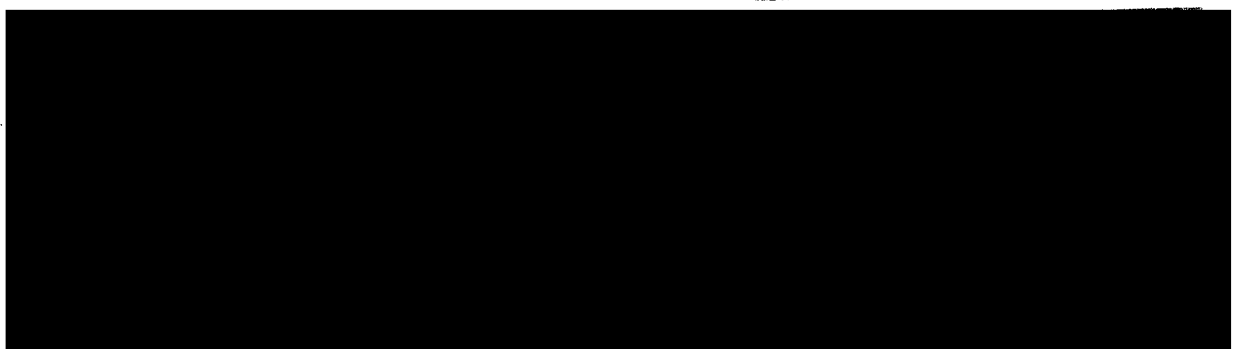

1. The offices of the Central Committee of the Czechoslovak Communist Party (KSC), including the office of Rudolf Slansky, Secretary-General of the Party, were moved into the building of the "Pamatnik odboje" (Resistance Memorial) at Praha-Zizkov in the middle of February 1949. The Military Historical Institute and Museum have been moved out of the building.
2. Confidential meetings of the Central Committee of the KSC are currently taking place at this new Party headquarters. On 8 March 1949, for instance, there was such a meeting in Rudolf Slansky's office. Secretaries and typists work in shifts and are on duty 24 hours a day.
