Malchin-Waren (U38-U25)

- In addition to a district komendatura, Malchin is occupied by approximately 100 motorized rifle troops who, together with 200 German police, were seen training with carbines and Soviet MGs.
- According to the director of the telephone exchange, Waren is held only by komendatura troops. The wooded area between Maren and Malchin was recently surveyed by tank officers.
- Teterow (U28)

Unoccupied. The former emergency airfield has been destroyed.

- Glistroy (T98)
 - The artillery barracks and the airfield have been destroyed. The Infanterie Kaserne is partly occupied by German civilians and also serves as a headquarters for the komendatura and an MVD detachment. Some part of this Kaserne is also used by officers working at the Primaburg munitions plant situated between Gustrow and Teterow. These officers use motorcycles C 00-71 to 76 and vehicle / 15-18.
 - According to employees, the Primaburg plant is producing ammunition of all calibers and new ammunition bunkers are being built in the area.

Warmenfinde (082)

The Karl Liebknecht Dockyards are guarded by Soviet MPs and motorized German police. These new yards are to extend south as far as the former Heinkel commound between Warnemunde and Rostock. A new railroad siding has been completed and a streetcar connection between the Heinkel compound and Rostock is under construction. A former German freighter of 15,000 tons and three German torpedo boats are still under repair in the port. A Soviet navel unit uses vehicles (8-41-62 to 86.

Local workers report that dockyard equipment is being delivered by sea from the former Elbing submarine yards.

Rostock (081)

- No troops were observed anywhere within the city. Barracks lying in the direction of Warnemunde and Doberan were evacuated and the Fusilier Kaserne is held by 800-900 German police.
- In Rostock port, five torpedo boats and one destroyer are being repaired. Soviet naval officers at the Neptun-Werft use vehicles \$ 5-15-02 to 24. The former Heinkel seaplane area has been blocked off. Source observed, in this area, mechanized troops in trucks / 3-29-41 to 73.

6. Stralsund (P44)

- Stralsund is occupied by a komendatura and an engineer headquarters which services units on Rugen Island. Source observed two engineer vehicles: 1 8-52-13 and 1 8-53-82. There are no troops at Darss and Zingst, northwest of Stralsund.
- Barracks in this area:

Hafenkasernen

: Partly used as billets for German rersonnel, partly being dismantled.

Rostocker Chaussee

: Being partly dismantled.

Bodden/Greifswalder Chaussee : Destroyed.

Barth airfield and KZ barracks: Chiefly demolished, though some refugees are still living in them. The airfield runway is intact.

Greifswald (P72)

Barracks on the Anklam highway have been destroyed. There are no troops in this area.
