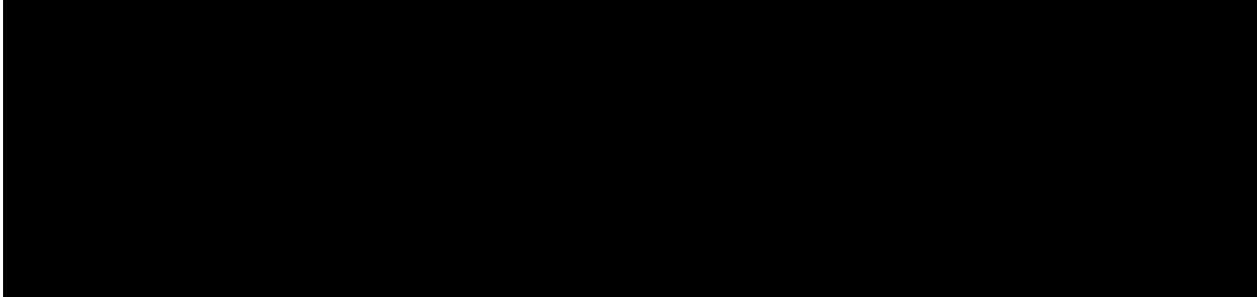

Adolfo Ortega Diaz, well-known Nicaraguan revolutionary now in San Jose, Costa Rica, received a communication on 12 April 1949 from Ernesto Solorzano Thompson, Nicaraguan revolutionary contact in New York, in which Solorzano stated that General Emiliano Chamorro did not wish to purchase two previously discussed PBX-5A amphibious airplanes.* Chamorro felt that the price of the planes was out of the reach of revolutionary funds. He further suggested that the dummy aircraft corporation to be set up in connection with the above purchase be abandoned.**
2. In his message Solorzano Thompson asked Ortega Diaz if certain unidentified elements would remain stagnant in Guatemala. Source stated that this was probably a reference to the Patriotic Nicaraguan Committee group of Carlos Castillo Ibarra which is known to be concentrating heavily upon their potential Guatemalan resources at the present time. In this connection source noted that Rosendo Arguello, Jr., returned to San Jose from Guatemala on 18 April 1949.
