1. To cover its scrap steel requirements for 1949, Hungary has placed the following orders, although deliveries have not yet been made:

2. The following further offers have been made, but not yet been accepted by the Hungarians:

- Abel - 5,000 tons of steel scrap, 500 tons of steel casting.
- Voss (Berlin) - 20,000 tons of steel scrap.

Voss obtains its steel scrap [redacted] smuggles it 50X1-HUM into the Eastern Zone.

3. The Hungarians hope to obtain a further 20,000 tons of steel scrap [redacted] 50X1-HUM 50X1-HUM

4. If all these negotiations succeed, Hungary's steel scrap requirements for 1949 will be covered.
