1. [ ] the following Czechoslovakian officers had been discharged recently:

- a. General MARKO: Chief of the Signal Troops Command at the Ministry of National Defense, a Slovak, was allegedly arrested after being discharged, present whereabouts unknown.
- b. General KOVAC: Formerly Chief of Military Construction work at the Ministry of National Defense.
- c. General GREEK: Chief of the Armament Section at the Ministry of National Defense.
- d. Twenty additional officers of the Military Technical Institute.

- 2. Comment:
  - a. General MARKO had last been confirmed in November 1948 as Chief of the Signal Troops Command.
  - b. Generals KOVAC and GREEK are unknown.
