1. a. A rear detail of about 50 men, some wearing tank insignia, was located in the former Flak Kaserne, WURZEN (N 52/E 42), on 18 June 1949. Passenger car [redacted] was seen leaving the kaserne. 50X1-HUM

b. [redacted] motor vehicles were observed in front of the houses on Rosenweg which were occupied by Soviet dependents: 50X1-HUM

2. a. Intensive work was being done in the Soviet motor vehicle repair shop on Lueptitzerstrasse. About 250 trucks were parked at a former drill ground, about one thousand feet northeast of the repair shop. Trucks [redacted] were being towed to the repair shop. 50X1-HUM

b. About 150 overhauled trucks [redacted] were parked between two large factory buildings of the repair shop. The entraining for an unknown destination of 25 of the 150 trucks was observed. 50X1-HUM

c. Trucks [redacted] were parked in front of the repair shop: 50X1-HUM

3. a. [redacted] truck [redacted] were [redacted] in front of a Soviet storage depot on Dredener Strasse: 50X1-HUM

a. Component units of the 8th Gds Mecz Div had already been transferred from their WURZEN post to the KOENIGS-  
BRUECK troop training grounds in mid April 1949.

b. The following two motor vehicle repair shops are known to be located in WURZEN:

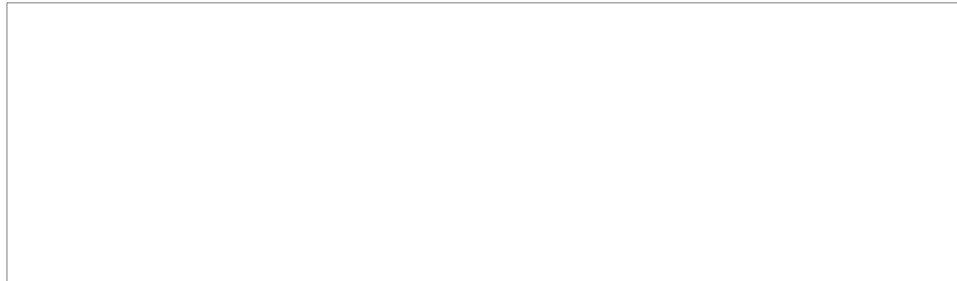
