1. The following [REDACTED] were secured in POTSDAM (N 53/Z 63) on 5 July 1949:

25X1C [REDACTED] Unit commanded by Maj. KUPRIYANOV.

25X1C [REDACTED] Unit in the former Adolf Hitler Kaserne on Pappel-Allee, POTSDAM. The unit had formerly been located in the former "Heeres Reit- und Fahrschule". Capt. ILYUKHININ was assigned to this unit. [REDACTED] Unit with which Capt. TETTELMANN was identified. 25X1C

25X1A * [REDACTED] Comment: [REDACTED] Reported by US source late in 1946 to be assigned to the Office of the Chief of Tank and Mecc Administration of the Group of Occupation Forces Germany (GOFG). Shipments for this [REDACTED] were frequently dispatched from the area of BERLIN to KIRCHHOESEN in 1948. POTSDAM has not yet been mentioned. 25X1C

25X1A ** [REDACTED] Comment: [REDACTED] Military Procurement Section of the GOFG. The [REDACTED] was reported from various towns of the Soviet Zone of Germany. Another source identified the APN in the "Heeres Reit- und Fahrschule", POTSDAM-KRAMPNITZ, on 19 May 1949. 25X1C

25X1A *** [REDACTED] Comment: [REDACTED] repeatedly observed in POTSDAM-BABELSBERG up to May 1948. 25X1C

25X1A [REDACTED] Comment: The officers mentioned in the above report are not known.
