

- no Soviet troops were located in the area of KATOWICE (Q 51/Y 57) in mid-June 1949.
- 2. Civilians stated that Soviet kommandanturas were located in the following towns: KATOWICE, RYBNIK (2 51/Y 25), CHORZOW (2 51/Y 57) GLEIWITZ (0 51/Y 37) and DOMBROWA (2 51/Y 67).
- Relations between soviet troops and Poles were considerably strained.

The report confirms other information, according to which no major Soviet Army units have been observed in the industrial area of Upper Silesia since the beginning of 1949.
