1. [redacted] no Soviet troops were located in the area of KATOWICE (Q 51/Y 57) in mid-June 1949.
2. Civilians stated that Soviet kommandanturas were located in the following towns: KATOWICE, RYBNIK (Q 51/Y 25), CHORZOW (Q 51/Y 57) GLEBIWITZ (O 51/Y 37) and DOMBROWA (Q 51/Y 67).
3. Relations between Soviet troops and Poles were considerably strained.

[redacted] The report confirms other information, according to which no major Soviet Army units have been observed in the industrial area of Upper Silesia since the beginning of 1949.
