

- 2. A member of each Chinese family was required to take part in each parade.
- 3. At public meetings and during parades the USSR flag was prominently displayed as were pictures of MAO Tse-tung and Stalin side by side. Representatives of the USSR came from Peiping to speak at public meetings. Concern was expressed by some Chinese that a picture of Stalin was displayed above those of Chinese Communist leaders.
- Pictures were not allowed to be taken without permits, which were impossible to obtain. One American was arrested for taking pictures; his film was confiscated and he was later released.
