1. 1. July 1949

The standard gauge line from ZWOENITZ (N 51/K 53) to STOLLBERG (N 51/K 54) was opened again.

2. 25 and 26 July 1949

On the occasion of a railway trip the source observed that the ZWOENITZ-STOLLBERG single-track line had again been operating for some time.

Comment: The ZWOENITZ-STOLLBERG line, which was dismantled after the war, has been reconstructed in connection with the uranium mining conducted around AUE (N 51/K 53). Its chief purpose at present is to provide transportation to the uranium mines for the workers living north of AUE.
