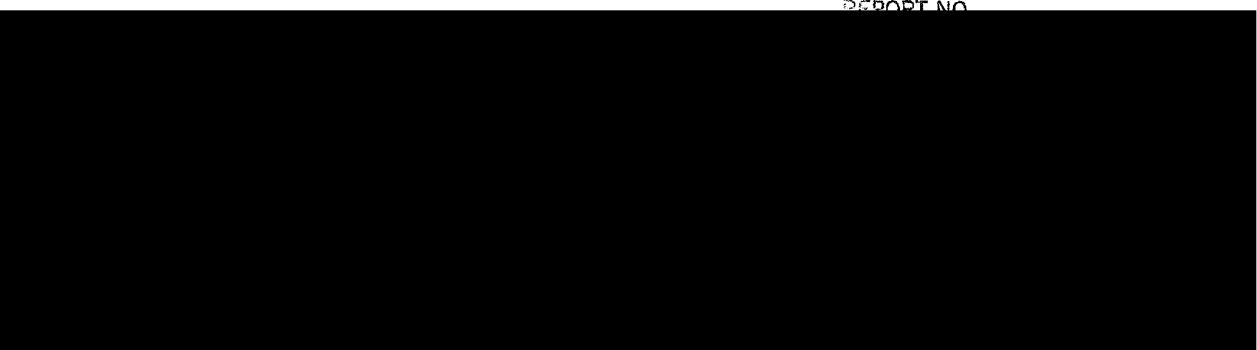

- Recent reports regarding Communist Party organization in Thailand suggest that possibly there is only one party and not, as previously thought, a branch of the Chinese Communist Party alongside a small native Thai Communist Party. If this is true, the organization presumably follows that of the Malayan Communist Party.
- Communist efforts to strengthen their propaganda in Thailand continue. In late July 1949, representatives of the dissident Kuomintang parties were invited to join in a League of Chinese Democratic Journalists in Bangkok, in order to "counterbalance reactionary propaganda".
