## 21 August 1949

25X1C 1. a. The following observations were made in CCTTBUS (N 52/A 57):

Sachsendorf Kaserne:

25X1C

Occupied to capacity by about two thousand troops. Some guns were observed in the kaserne area.

Hermann Loens Kaserne:

Occupied to capacity by about 1,500 troops. Tanks were allegedly parked in the woods behind the kaserne.

Funker Kaserne on Burger Chaussee:

Occupied to capacity by a unit of about five hundred men, allegedly a supply unit.


## 7 August 1949

b. The Alvensleben Kaserne on Viehmarkt was occupied by artillery units with 24 guns of about 100 mm caliber.

c. The following motor vehicles were identified in the streets of COTTBUS:

# 18 Au not 1949

a. A train of 3 boxears and about 20 gendels cars, each carrying one truck, was observed at the CUTIBUS freight station. The touck was observed. 25X1C

#### 22 nu ust 1949

b. A tank unit, which was stationed at the cirfield, was detrained at the COTTBUS railroad station. The three hundred troops of the unit were detrained in the evening, while the tanks were unloaded and driven away during the night. Maj KOTCLIL AI was identified as CO of the tank unit in the former Funker haserne.

### 24 Au tot 1949

c. The Gorman population was ordered to evacuate the "denn-bahn" and "Jindmuchlen" settlements near the COTTBUS airfield. The former Bismurck Schule, COLTBUS, was again requisitioned, allegedly to serve as officers' mess and club.

# 8 September 1949

- The following observations were made in COTTBUS: 3.
  - Former Artillerie (alvensleben) Kaserne on Vielmarkt:

Occupied by artillery units with about four hundred troops, including recruits between 18 and 20 years of age. Four 182-am gune, three 76.2-am guns with uzzle brake and two battery co mander's telescopes were observed in the kaserne area. The passenger car left the kaserne. 25X1C

b. Hermann Loene Kauerne:

25X1C

Occupied by a tank unit. Three tanks were parked in front of no training of troops was observed. The truck with hoisting gear was seen in the haserne area, 25X1C and the pauseager car leaving the kaserne.

c. Former Funker Kaserne on Burjer Chaussee:

Occupied to eapacity by six hundred troops. About a hundred troops done trained in the kaserne area with four 37-ma antisircraft jums on four-wheel mounts. The truck 25X1C

### Comment:

Local residents stated that about a thousand troops with 20 T-34 tanks and two tracks had arrived in COTEMUS on 31 August 1949 aboard a train coming from the direction of FOLOT (0 52/A 77). The troops had moved into the Jacksondorf Maserne.

25X1C Comment:

a. From the information supplied by on the COTTBed military post from mid-August to early deptember 1949 it
is assumed that most of the CoTTBUD units of the 9th Necz
Div (Cadre) were in their basernes at that time. However,
it cannot be determined if the reported troops in the COTTBUD
kasernes were primarily recruits, since some or the combat units
were reported absent on maneuvers. For example, it is assumed

from previous information that component units of the 9th Recz Div (Cadre) were engaged in field exercises in the JERDER-AMERIDORF training area and in the area south of DIJSWASSER.

b. Maj LUTULE SAT was identified for the first time in the CUTTBUS Punker Kaserne. The 1719th AAA Rejt (Cadre) of the 9th Mecz Div (Cadre) is assumed to also be stationed in this kaserne, according to previous reports.
