- An estate employee in Bantam says that Tan Malaka is in Bantam and is personally organizing the Murba groups. He heard Tan Malaka speak at a rally in a village near Tangka Betung.
- The current propaganda line of Tan Malaka is that the Indonesians will be aided by the Chinese Communists.

About 1 November 1949

- Tan Malaka is not likely to start any heavy opposition to the Republik Indonesia Serikat for about six months.
- There is an unknown number of Chinese Communists from Kuala Lumpur in Bantam at present.
