1. Three trains with a total of about 120 flatcars, loaded with Soviet motor vehicles, passed through SIERADZ (Q 52/C 42). According to rumors, these trains came from Silesia and were to proceed northward.

2. One train of 30 flatcars loaded with Soviet guns passed through TOMASZO"-MAZO"-IECKI (Q 52/P 31) and proceeded west. Several west-bound ammunition trains moved through TOMASZO"-MAZO"-IECKI.

[REDACTED] Comment:

a. Another source reported that a Soviet tank unit was entrained in LIEGMITZ for an unidentified destination in late October 1949. It cannot be stated whether the trains which passed through SIERADZ carried troops and materiel withdrawn from the LIEGMITZ area, or whether they carried routine shipments of motor vehicles to be repaired or already repaired.

b. The train with Soviet guns observed in TOMASZO"-MAZO"-IECKI, possibly proceeded to the Soviet Zone of Germany.
