No Czechoslovakian Army military posts were located along the eastern border of Slovakia in late September 1949. The following units in eastern Slovakia wers known: TREBISOV (R 49/E 62): One infantry bottalion MICHALOVCE (0 51/G 00): One infantry battalion One engineer battalion PRESOV (R 49/E 37): One battalion of the 4th Sig Regt One motor transport battalion Infantry and artillery units. 2. Czechoslovacian soldiers stated that a self-propelled artillery unit was located in TURGIARSKY Sv.MARTIN (2 50/0 69) barracks which had previously been occupied by the leactivated 24th Pank Brig. They also reported that Division General PAPCUCEK, the previous CG of the Czechoslovakian Tank Troops, was relieved of his command by 31-year-old Col. Viadimir JANKO, a notorious Communist. 3. It was statel that the headquarters of a mobile division, commanded by an officer named DOVIAK (or similar name), was located in SILINA (2 50/0 92). 4. There were runors in Slovakia that Soviet material depots were to be established in this border area of eastern Clovakia. (4) PRESOV signal battalion: (of the 4th big megt)

Probably the II on of the 4th oil Regt.

(5) PRESOV motor transport battalion:

Not yet ilentified; previously ruported in April 1948.

(6) PRESOV infantry unit:

Proceedly the 20th inf Regt.

(7) Pausov artillery anit:

Battelion of the 11th Arty Acit, AcilCL.

b. The report confirmed the descrivation of the 24th Tunk Drig in ToddIATSKY SV MARTIL, which had, so far, been reported by only one source. \$\mathref{\rho}\$.

c. Since the list of Jzeczeslovskian divisions omitted the SIMMA 4th Latz Inf Div . it was assumed that the division no longer existed. It appears doubtful if source's knowledge about the SIMMA headquarters of a motorized infantry division was current, particularly since part of the information was also supplied by soldiers.

d. The reported succession of Jeneral Papoussk by Jol JAnko has not been substantiated.
