SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.



- The so-called MVD War Institute was located on Leningrad Highway, MOSCOW, about 1,100 feet west of Belorussian Railroad Station and about 1,600 feet east of the Aeronautics +nstitute. It was in a large E-shaped building, having a frontage of about 330 feet and three wings about 150 feet each.
- 2. The institute was under the Ministry of the Interior. conducted courses for MVD headquarters and unit officers, from first lieutenant to colonel, between the ages of 30 - 35 years. During the six-month courses the officers were organized into class-room units of about 150 officers. There were usually four or five such units at a time.
- The institute was headed by a genleit, and eight other generals were instructors. The atudents were regular officers, Heroes of the Soviet Union. They were billeted in the institute in 20-man rooms.
- Besides lecture rooms and quarters, a printing shop (in the basement), a foreign-language school, and special branch-ofservice sections (artillery, engineer, and signal sections) were in the institute building. A target range was behind the building.
- It was believed that the trainees were primarily instructed in tactical and political masters. They often left for tactical walks.
- 6. A guard unit of about two hundred MVD troops armed with pistols and a motor pool with a few passenger cars and about 40 trucks, mostly ZIS, Molotov, and Studebaker makes, were assigned to the institute.
- 7. An MD administration office was possibly located in the building, took
