1. The WIBLER-NEUBAUPT (O 48/X 35) airfield was occupied by 38 Pe-2s, 10 DC-3s, 5 biplanes, and about 40 fighters.

[redacted] were observed in front of the former Nachrichten Kaserne on Pernersdorferstrasse now occupied by Soviet Air Force troops.

Comment:

a. The presence of Pe-2s was reported [redacted] on 17 October 1949. Only individual Pe-2s have so far been seen at the field. The occupation by a unit equipped with Pe-2s is considered doubtful since the presence of a large number of Pe-2s has not been reported by other sources.

b. A smaller number of fighters was mentioned than previously. It has not been learned if one of the two fighter regiments previously stationed in WIBLER-NEUBAUPT has been transferred.
