- 25X1A A Loslem guerrilla, who surrendered to Greek authorities stated that he had gone with four others to Irespa to attend the Second MOF Congress, as a delegate of the Moslom minority in Greece. He stated that the delegation rechod Prespa via Bulgaria and Yugoslavia. Not far from the Bulgarian-Yugoslav frontier the delegation was net by sixty unarmed Contunist Greek guerrillas. Both parties were put on Yugoslav trucks and were taken to Prespa. They returned to the region of Komotini the same way.
- The 3d Assembly of the Union of Agricultural Cooperatives of Korestia 2. took place on 15 May 1949. Agricultural subjects were discussed, and they also discussed helping the Greek guerrillas by means of farm products. They elected a new five-number executive Council. Four of the five who were elected belong to MOF, and all the alternate members elected belong to MOF.
- The NOF paper Bilton, dated 10 April 1949, reportedly mentioned a camp for abducted Greek children at Llaton-Kenese (sic), in Hungary.
- On 23 April 1949, the ROF newspaper, Bilton published an item according to which the Kulaitziev, Vine-resident of the Central consistee of the Cultural and Educational Brotherhoods of Pirin Macedonia, participated in the NOF Congress of 25 March 1949, as a representative of Pirin Macedonia.
