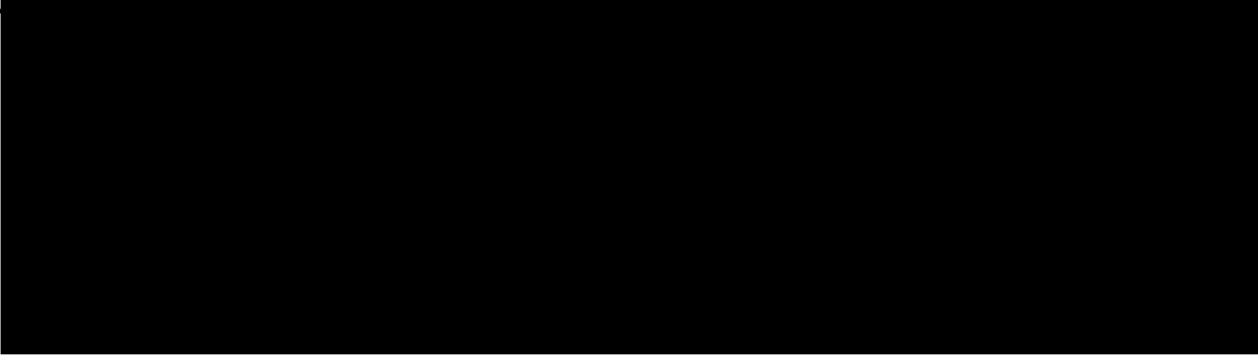

1. A Moslem guerrilla, who surrendered to Greek authorities [redacted] 25X1A stated that he had gone with four others to Prespa to attend the Second NOF Congress, as a delegate of the Moslem minority in Greece. He stated that the delegation reached Prespa via Bulgaria and Yugoslavia. Not far from the Bulgarian-Yugoslav frontier the delegation was met by sixty unarmed Communist Greek guerrillas. Both parties were put on Yugoslav trucks and were taken to Prespa. They returned to the region of Komotini the same way.
2. The 3d Assembly of the Union of Agricultural Cooperatives of Korestia took place on 15 May 1949. Agricultural subjects were discussed, and they also discussed helping the Greek guerrillas by means of farm products. They elected a new five-member Executive Council. Four of the five who were elected belong to NOF, and all the alternate members elected belong to NOF.
3. The NOF paper Bilten, dated 10 April 1949, reportedly mentioned a camp for abducted Greek children at Klaton-Kenese (sic), in Hungary.
4. On 23 April 1949, the NOF newspaper, Bilten published an item according to which Ch. Kulaitziev, Vice-president of the Central Committee of the Cultural and Educational Brotherhoods of Pirin Macedonia, participated in the NOF Congress of 25 March 1949, as a representative of Pirin Macedonia.
5. The following persons are said to be members of the Central Committee of the NOF:

President

Pashalis Mitropoulos, son of Gregorios and Hariclea from Tsculcas, Kasteria, and resident of Argous Orestikou.

Vice-President

Evdokia Baliou or Balava (Vera Nikolovska), daughter of Nicholas and Eugenia, from Dendrecheri, Kasteria.

Secretary

Evangolos Koitsis (Vangel Koitsoff), son of Georgios and Volika, from Velis, Florina.
