- The Yugoslav Air Force is reportedly operating a powerful radio station near Zadar. The station, which previously belonged to the government police, is under military guard. This is not the former Italian network station, which is currently being operated as a civilian station, but one which has been built over the remains of a station built by the Italian Army during the war.
- 2. The Air Force installations in Zadar are being built up with a view to making it the most important air base in Yugoslavia. A section of the pilot school has been transferred to this base. The runways are being enlarged and service installations are in the process of completion.
