Acting on information that the Northeastern Army Command at Korat (Nakorn Ratsima) had received frequent coded radio messages* from Bangkok instructing the commanders to march on the capital and seize it, the Thai Police during December 1949 searched the jail cells** in which the October 1948 Coup participants are detained. Though the search revealed no evidence of coding or transmitting activities, the messages continued to be received in Korat after the search.
