At the end of September 1949, an important Viet Minh can-bo named Duong Gia Thosi (Zuong Gia Thosi)* arrived at the Vietnam Delegation on Sathorn Road, Bangkok. Thosi was born about 1914 in Cochinchina and received a good French education. Before and during the war, he was a teacher of French and English in a public school in Saigon. In 1947, he went to Tonkin where, until Earch 1949, he stayed in the same general eres as Ho Chi Linh. He then returned to Cochinchina and in September 1949, came to Bangkok to serve in the Delegation. He is at present Secretary-General of the Administrative Committee of the Delegation. He is also liaison man between the most important Cochinchinese committee (that of Tran Van Giau) and the Viet Minh can-bo in the Delegation (the Ho Chi Minh group). He is held in high esteem by Nguyen Duc Cuy, Le Duy Luong**, and also by Xom, 25X1X He is thought to be a member of the Indochinese Communist Party. 5. Comment.
