1. More than one hundred Soviet officers, but few SM, were staying in BAD LANDECK (P 51/H 43) in late October 1949, allegedly for a rest.
2. MVD Maj MASLAKOV was identified as the BAD LANDECK post commander.
3. It was learned that Marshal ROKOSOVSKI frequented BAD LANDECK. His daughter allegedly met with a fatal accident there in 1944 while tobogganing.
4. Greek partisans, wounded in action, and Greek children were accomodated in BAD LANDECK and its vicinity in the Summer of 1949.
