- 1. Although Civil Air Transport (CAT) cancelled all flights to Hong Kong until its position was clarified (because CAT feared that the Hong Kong Government might impound its planes), a decision was later made to continue the flights until the Chinese Communist government in Peiping cancels the CAT registration, at which time all CAT flights will be stopped (B-6) [REDACTED]
- 2. Approximately 1,000 pro-Communist employees of the China National Aviation Corporation (CNAC) will go to Tientsin in mid-January for indoctrination concerning reorganization of the airline under Communist management. It has been announced that a similar indoctrination for employees of the Central Air Transport Corporation (CATC) will be held in Canton.
