1. Rumanian mountain infantry units were entrained at the CAMPIA TURZII (R 36/R 08) railroad station on 29 October 1949. Four field officers, including one colonel, were seen with the troops. The units were armed with light and heavy machine guns and "ZB" rifles and submachine guns.
2. The designation of the troops could not be ascertained. They were allegedly to proceed northward.

Comment:

The CAMPIA TURZII railroad station is located in the DJU-FARGU-MURDS-AJUD area, where mountain troops are stationed. The mountain unit (mountain infantry battalion?) was probably entrained for fall maneuvers or for return to its station. The Rumanian Army maneuvers were generally completed in late September 1949.
