1. [Redacted] in the area of the GOETZER BERG (N 53/Z 33) no evidence of Soviet signal installations.

a. [Redacted] not [Redacted] any Soviet installation in the GOETZ area. 50X1-HUM

b. [Redacted] no military installation is known in the GOETZER BERG area except a Soviet dog breeding farm. 50X1-HUM

c. All hills of the GOETZER BERG area suitable for the installation of radar sets [Redacted] but only a wooden tower of a triangulation point which looked somewhat strange with its many cross struts, was seen on a ridge between two hills, about a mile north of the GOETZ railroad station. 50X1-HUM

d. The Soviet dog breeding farm opposite the brickyard [Redacted] there were 300 dogs tended by a soldier. The dogs, but not the soldier, were seen [Redacted] A Soviet bathing pool [Redacted] Several signboards with Russian inscription on the road leading to a steamer landing place indicated the way to the pool. [Redacted] Soviet officers frequently came to the hunting-site for hunting and fishing. 50X1-HUM

f. [Redacted] north of GOETZER BERG [Redacted] the Havel River cannot be crossed. As the terrain is considerably marshy [Redacted] 50X1-HUM

g. [Redacted] since no motor vehicle ruts or telephone lines were seen in the entire area. [Redacted] no Soviet soldiers have been stationed in GOETZ and its environs except for the Soviet officers who occasionally go there for hunting. 50X1-HUM
